3. How does Ashira's story mirror the modern abortion crisis, and what emotions does it stir in you?
4. How does Trent view his work? What cracks appear in his worldview during his lunch encounter with Eve?
5. Does Mitchell's rant against foster humanize him or deepen your frustration?

Why do you think Lisa confides in Eve about her past abortion? How would you have reacted in this situation? What facilitates her healing?

How do Gideon and Eve obey God's purpose for their lives? What does it cost them? What do they gain from it?
